PRESENTATION

This Master's Double Degree prepares high-level specialists in Applied Linguistics, in French and English, as well as in Digital Humanities. It is aimed at a wide range of **professional fields**, including linguistics for automatic language processing, terminology, translation, technical writing and linguistic tools.

This programme may also lead to **PhD studies** in France or Italy, particularly in the context of **joint supervision**. The Double Degree relies on leading research laboratories and departments, the LIDILEM research laboratory in Grenoble and the Department of Excellence in Foreign Languages and Literatures at the University of Verona.

ORGANISATION

This programme offers students mobility between Grenoble and Verona in order to enhance their linguistic, cultural and professional skills. The organisation of the semesters varies according to the Home University:

Students enrolled on the Double Degree programme follow the Digital Culture curriculum in Verona. In Grenoble, they follow Linguistics Masters course in Grenoble, enriched with language, literature and translation courses.

ADMISSION

This Master's Programme is aimed at students with a Bachelor's Degree in Language Sciences, Literature and Languages, who have knowledge of the fundamentals of Language Sciences and a **C1 level in French and English**. Admission procedures include an interview and a project.

APPLICATION

In Verona, application details will be posted on the University of Verona's Master's website. In Grenoble, applicants must submit their application on the Mon Master platform (information on the Master's website).

Applications will be examined by the Joint Studies Committee. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed and the results will be announced after the admissions committee.

PROGRAMME

- Year 1: reinforcement of fundamental disciplines in French Linguistics, English Linguistics, Applied Linguistics and Digital humanities; Literature for Verona students.
- Year 2: in-depth study of the fundamental disciplines (Applied Linguistics, French Linguistics, English Linguistics, Digital Humanities, Professional integration; Literature for Verona students). For Grenoble students an internship, lasting 4 to 6 months, in a company or laboratory.
- Italian language courses will be offered in Grenoble and Verona for students who so wish.

ADVANTAGES OF THE DOUBLE DEGREE

This Double Degree Programme is proposed by the two Universities with the aim of increasing the quality of training in the field of Applied Linguistics and Digital Humanities, based on the certified and accredited programmes of the UGA and UNIVR. Graduates who successfully complete the Double Degree Programme will receive degrees from both universities.



USEFUL INFORMATION

At the University of Verona, students will find useful information on the UNIVR website.

At UGA an information portal has been set up for international students: ISSO (International Students and Scholars Office). Within the LLASIC UFR, the International Relations Department guides students enrolled in the Double Degree Programme by directing them, for example, to the appropriate services for finding accommodation with ICampus.

Students enrolled in the Double Degree will have to pay the registration fees at their Home University (UNIVR or UGA). Students will receive an ERASMUS grant for the period of mobility, as well as possible assistance from the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes Region.
