MoCoSvi - MOBILITY PROJECTS FOR DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION

2022 Call for applications - Incoming mobility

Article 1 - AIMS

The University of Verona wishes to extend invitations to young researchers, university lecturers and scientists from institutions located in developing Countries, to spend a period of not less than **one month up to three months** in Verona in order to give lectures and/or carry out research with a Department.

Mobility projects for teaching and/or research purposes **should be related to development cooperation**, with the aim of improving sustainability as described by the United Nations Sustainable Development Agenda, such as reducing inequalities.

Home Institutions of invited researchers should be located in a Country listed in Annex 1.

Intended recipients:

- Type A1: young researchers such as PhD students, postdocs or trainee specialists, or lecturers with no more than 7 years' academic experience after having obtained their PhD.
- Type A2: university lecturers, academics.

Mobility stays must take place during the period from 1 January 2023 until 30 June 2024.

Article 2 - GRANT VALUES

Category A (incoming mobility):

The funded duration of stay for invited researchers is intended for a period of **one to three months**. However, researchers may stay in Verona for longer than the funded period.

The financial contribution is intended to partly support the cost of staying in Verona exclusively for the invited candidate and not to any accompanying persons. The amount will be determined based on the intended number of weeks of stay. It is not allowed under any circumstances to use the financial contribution to pay for entertainment expenses.

Accountable expenses: reimbursement of travel expenses and accommodation in Verona or wage – in this case, the total amount available is to be considered gross of any withholding tax to be paid by the University and the recipient as provided by law. Payments to guests of non-EU nationality must comply with the provisions of law related to their type of visa to enter Italy. Article 3 - AVAILABLE FUNDS

The total available budget amounts to €15,000 for incoming and outgoing mobility projects.

Article 4 - SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications must be submitted by a Professor or a Researcher of the University of Verona. Each applicant should proceed as follows:

- 1. Fill out the application form online;
- 2. Where required, and in accordance with the chosen category, attach the necessary documentation (in electronic format only) for the project to be evaluated. In particular:

The **deadline** for completing and submitting applications **online** is **15 November 2022** at **12:00 noon** (Italian time).

Article 5 - EVALUATION CRITERIA

The evaluation criteria are as follows:

Article 6 - PREPARATION OF RANKINGS

After the deadline of 15 November 2022, a University's Selection Committee will meet to compile a general ranking, based on the evaluation criteria detailed in Art. 5. Final results will be published on the University website after formal approval of the University Bodies (expected approval: end of December 2022).
