Orientation Course

The Orientation Course is free of charge and it is compulsory for all new students. It is organised at the beginning of the semester. During the course, students will hear about studying at the University, student life and services for students in Tampere. Further information: www.uta.fi/admissions/university

Registration

New students are required to enrol at the Registrar's Office and bring the documents listed in the Letter of Acceptance with them. The registration materials are available at the International Office. Exchange students of the University are encouraged to pay the voluntary membership fee of the Student Union of University of Tampere (58 € for one semester, 116 € for the academic year). On payment of this fee, students receive an official student card. As members of the Student Union, exchange students are entitled to use the services of the Student Union as well as the student health care services. For international exchange students pursuing a PhD degree at their home universities, the voluntary membership fee is 24,50 € for one semester, 49 € for the academic year. PhD students are not entitled to travel discounts or to the student health care services.

Student Tutoring

At the University of Tampere, a student tutor is assigned to every international exchange student. The tutor is a fellow student who can help new exchange students with practicalities, such as finding their way to their accommodation and helping them plan their study schedule. The contact information of the student tutor will be sent to the incoming exchange students after the application and acceptance process.

Credits and Grading

Finnish credits are ECTS compatible, i.e. one Finnish credit (opintopiste) corresponds to one ECTS credit.

Grading of Exams

A 5-tier grading scale (5-1) is used at the University of Tampere. It is compatible with the ECTS grading scale (A-E). Furthermore, pass/fail (HYV/HYL) is used in course evaluation as such without grading to indicate that the student has fulfilled / not fulfilled the requirements set in the curriculum for the course.

Transcript of Academic Records

The transcripts of the exchange students will be sent to their home addresses in their home countries after the exchange period. The request needs to be made at the Registrar's Office of the University of Tampere before departure.

Student Housing
