What is an exchange student?

- An exchange student is a student (i.e. officially registered at an institution for higher education) who temporarily lives in a foreign country and attends courses or is involved in other academic activities.
- The exchange period at UGent lasts a minimum of 1 month and a maximum of 12 months.
- The exchange student does NOT get a diploma from UGent. However, all academic results will be sent to his/her university abroad via the <u>European Credit Transfer System</u> (ECTS).

This is what you will have to do if you want to become an **EXCHANGE STUDENT** at our university:

1. ACCEPTANCE as Exchange Student:

- Ask the **International Office in your university** to help you with the **5 necessary forms**. Without these documents, you can not be allowed as Exchange Student at Ghent University.
- Once we have received these forms, they will be sent to the faculty responsible and UGent professor. If they agree with the proposed forms, they will sign them and send them back to me.
- I will return the forms to you and your university by e-mail. I will also send your original 'Letter of Invitation' to your postal address.
- This procedure usually takes a **4 6 weeks**. During the holiday period, it might take a bit longer.
- Here you can find the link to the **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**.
- If you have already sent these documents, it's <u>not</u> necessary to send them again.
- Attention: <u>faculties</u> have application deadlines! However, we advice you to send your forms minimum 2-3 months BEFORE your arrival date in Gent. If this is not possible, please inform us.
