Language requirement	<p>At the time of writing, we do not require any official certification of French level. However, students must be sufficiently proficient in French to be able to follow classes and complete coursework.</p> <p>Most classes are taught in French. Very few courses are offered in English at Lyon 2. Students will not be able to follow a 100% English-language program</p>	
Tuition fees:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For European exchange students : no tuition - For non-European exchange students : 215 euros for the mandatory student's health insurance will have to be paid once at the University

Student's procedure for enrolling in classes	<p>- Attend classes which exchange students are interested in Exchange students are free to choose each class they want from any undergraduate program [L1 to L3] and first-year master's [M1] classes available, with the exception of professional classes [L2 & L3 pro] and "DU" program classes. Student may not enroll in second year master's classes [M2]. They can also choose classes from Université Catholique de Lyon, Institut d'Etudes Politiques, Ecole Normale Supérieure Lyon, Université Jean Moulin Lyon III and Université Claude Bernard Lyon I, if and only if the equivalent course is not taught at Université Lumière Lyon II.</p> <p>- Fill out the "contrat pédagogique" [course enrollment contract] we provide to students with title of the class, the corresponding course enrollment code, the teachers' signatures, etc.</p> <p>- Return this document within 3 weeks to the incoming students manager for registration</p> <p>- Verify class registration and request changes (remove / add classes, or to decide to turn a class with mark into "without a mark" and the other way around within one more weeks) After this period, please note that it is not possible to make changes anymore</p>
