

Vademecum for compiling your Learning Agreement

General information

If you are a student planning your Erasmus+ mobility, you must complete a Learning Agreement (LA).

The Learning Agreement sets out the studies program or the traineeship to be followed abroad. It must be approved by the student, the sending and the receiving institution, organization or enterprise before the start of the exchange.

Attendance and Scheduling conflict: Lessons of courses belonging to different years may overlap and attendance is mandatory at the University of Verona.

In this vademecum, we want to focus on where to find the information needed in Table A of your LA.

You can add those four types of activities to your LA.

a. Insegnamenti

On our website, you can find a [list](#) of all our courses. You can find all the course information by clicking on one of our courses and going to the correct academic year.

1. It has a **component code** or teaching code (in this case, 4S01161). All of our activities have a component code. This number is very important to pinpoint the course you want to attend.
2. It has a **component title**
3. It has a **term** (e.g., 2° semester). Please note that if you stay only one semester, you cannot attend the courses that are annual (for example, *Internal Medicine* or *Medical Clinic, gerontology and medical treatment*) and you can attend courses that take place in your semester (for more information, please look at the “Academic Calendar”).
4. It has n. **credits** (= ECTS)
5. The name of the coordinator of the course
6. Some courses include a practical part. If that is the case, you’ll find it on the page of the course, under the indication of “*tirocinio*” or “*didattica pratica*”.

We are sorry to inform you that Erasmus students are not allowed to take “Public health” course.

Some of our courses are composed of two or more modules. If that is the case, you'll find each module listed at the bottom of the course page. You can click on each module to see its program, coordinator, etc.

For example, Neurosurgery is a part of the Neurology course:

1. It has the same teaching code as the main course
2. but it has a different teacher, a different title and a different number of ECTS.

You may choose to include the whole course in your LA or to attend individual modules. If you only wish to attend one or a few of the modules, you'll have to list every one of them in you LA, using their correct name and number of ECTS.

Exceptions:

1. Some of you might be interested in the practical module of one of our courses (e.g., "SEMINARS ON PEDIATRICS AND DIDACTIC PRACTICE IN PEDIATRICS") without wanting to attend the lessons and sit the exam. In this case, don't put the practical module in the LA and put an elective internship instead (see Section c., "*Corsi elettivi*", of this document)
2. Systematic pathology I and II: these courses are made of many modules, each corresponding to a subject that is part of the course (e.g., "*Dermatology*"). Each subject has its own practical part. However, the practical parts have all been put in the same module.
If you are only interested in some of the subjects and in their practical component, don't insert the "Didattica pratica" module in the LA and insert an elective internship for each subject instead (see Section c., "*Corsi elettivi*", of this document).

c. [Corsi elettivi](#)

The [list of elective courses](#) and all the information are constantly updated on each course's webpage.

The page is similar to the page of *insegnamenti*. It has a component code (1), a component title (2), a semester (3) and a specific timetable (3).

Please note that the timetables of the elective courses are updated frequently and that they are usually definitive only at the beginning of the semester. Elective courses only take place after 5.30 pm, to allow students to attend their lessons, so a few of them overlap. We suggest to stick to a limited number of elective courses and to be open to the possibility that you might have to change some of them as the semester starts, if they end up overlapping.

Eligibility is usually based on attendance.

For the inclusion of elective internships in your LA, it is always advisable to contact the Buddy service. A partial list of elective internships with the correct component code and the title is included at the end of this document.

1ECTS = 1 week-long internship.

Glossary

Corsi elettivi

Elective courses are courses complementary to the compulsory plan for medical students.

The list of elective courses changes from year to year.

Since the courses have a limited number of places, it is possible that not all the courses offered are accessible.

Formulating a Learning agreement with the definitive elective courses is suggested as soon as possible to facilitate the organization.

Insegnamento

The courses are the list of exams offered by the Medicine Course.

Internato elettivo

Elective internships are internships in clinical wards which are not accompanied by a theoretical assessment of the skills acquired.

Attendance for the internship is certified by the tutor in the Libretto Rosso (red booklet) and recorded at the end of the Erasmus period.

Please ask the buddy service for the whole list of all the internati elettivi and their correct component code.

Libretto rosso

At the beginning of the Erasmus experience, the buddy service tutors will deliver a paper booklet. The clinical tutor must sign and stamp the booklet at the end of each practical activity.

The booklet must be returned to the secretariat at the end of the Erasmus period to allow the recording of practical activities.

Modulo

Part of a university course that focuses on a specific topic. A written or oral exam verifies knowledge and skills. Only passing the exam allows for acquiring a pre-established number of training credits (ECTS).

Not all teachings are divided into modules.
