### Requirements and tuition fees

- ▶ A French Language certificate is not required but a B1 level is highly recommended.
- ▶ No tuition fees, but non EU-students will be required to register to the Sécurité sociale (the French national health insurance system). The cost for the 2015-2016 year is 215 €.

## COURSES

- ▶ Law and political science
- ▶ Sciences: biology, chemistry, computer science, physics, mathematics, engineering, environmental engineering
- ▶ Social Sciences and Humanities: economics, management, administration, sociology, history, geography, literature and civilisation (French, Spanish and English)
- ▶ Medecine
- ▶ French as a foreign language: 2 courses offered per level
- ▶ Courses taught in English: American and English Literature and Civilisation, some International and Political Studies courses.

### Please note

- ▶ Odd semesters are scheduled in Autumn and even semesters in Spring.
- ▶ Students are required to choose a Major field of study but are free to take courses in other fields.
- ▶ The access to the following courses is not guaranteed: licence professionnelle (Vocational Licence), licence de musicologie (Music Theory Licence) and 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Master. Students need to contact the relevant teacher prior to arrival, to get permission to attend such courses.
