***Exchange in the field of Modern Languages: Additional requirements**

- **We can confirm that we require B2 English for all modules except those in English Literature, for which C1 is required. Students will be allowed to take one module in English Literature, but can also take modules in English Language from our English Language Teaching Unit.**

- This exchange permits students to study Modern Languages (French, Spanish and Italian) and English Language at the University of Leicester: **NB: the Language requirement for English Literature modules is needs to be at C1 level in English.**
- Modules in English Literature for Modern Languages exchange students are limited to a maximum of one module per academic year. Other arts and humanities modules may be selected by Modern Languages exchange students at the discretion of the relevant University of Leicester department.

General

- Erasmus incoming students are expected to be of good academic standing. Students and partners must note the University of Leicester module options and restrictions and check compatibility with their own curriculum prior to submitting their Erasmus application.
- Students may only attend for 1 semester or a full academic year (not 1 or 2 terms). Semester dates can be found at: www2.le.ac.uk/offices/governance/calendar/terms-and-semesters
- Erasmus students with disabilities may require support from several University services, including the University's AccessAbility Centre and relevant academic department. Partners should contact the Erasmus Team prior to student selection to discuss the possibilities.
