The objectives and goals are to strengthen and enhance the students' communication and comprehension skills in L2 by using French as a lingua franca. The project aims to increase motivation for learning the French language and to provide added value to students through collaboration with the German school. The methodology follows the principles of Cooperative Learning: the use of the foreign language in a peer context, with less reliance on the teacher; tasks are designed to involve different linguistic competencies and strategies; students are encouraged to share ideas, provide mutual support, and help one another; real communicative situations are created.
