With a student's reaching or surpassing this threshold, the assessment shall be indicated as sufficient – <b>A (pass)</b>, or, in the case of a student's not reaching the threshold, the assessment shall be indicated as not sufficient – <b>M (fail)</b>. <b>MI</b> - not attended.</p>
ECTS Credits	Tallinn University of Technology uses ECTS Grading System. One ECTS corresponds to twenty six (26) hours of studies (lectures, seminars, practice, home works) performed by student.

	1 full academic year=60 ECTS normal workload 1 semester=30 ECTS normal workload Minimum amount of ECTS, students have to apply, is 15 ECTS per semester, maximum no more than 40 ECTS.
Language requirements	Level of English must be at least <b>B2</b> for non-native speakers (For example: TOEFEL ibt 72, IELTS 5,5, TOEIC 780 and above).

Accommodation provided by TalTech	Academic Hostel <a href="https://www.academichostel.com/en/tut-exchange-students/">https://www.academichostel.com/en/tut-exchange-students/</a> provides limited number of places for exchange students. All the applicants get information after the application deadline, when and where they have to pay the deposit. First come, first served. Prices per person are about between 250 and 460 EUR, depends on the room. Private Accommodation	Private housing costs largely depend on the location and size of the flat. On average, the prices range from 400 (without utilities) to 800 EUR or more for an average private flat. During wintertime the utilities, additionally, might be around 300-600 EUR per month.
Living Expenses	Living expenses are lower than in <del>old</del> or northern EU countries, however higher than expected, usually. Each student can determine other expenses individually depending on their needs. No tuition and labs fees. Books are not purchased. <b>Housing:</b> Usually between 250-500 EUR per month. <b>Meal cost at TalTech canteens:</b> Morning 2-3 EUR, Lunch 5-7 EUR. Canteens are closed on Sundays and evenings. <b>Transport from the airport:</b> By taxi, single ride in Tallinn around 15-20 EUR. A single Bus ticket costs 2 EUR. <b>Local transport for getting to university:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students from third countries pay 30 EUR for 30 days.</li> <li>• EU students pay during the first month 30 EUR. Once they have registered the living place and got an Estonian ID card, the transport is free.</li> </ul> <b>Free time:</b> Depends on the student's lifestyle. From 0-1000 EUR per semester. <b>Any other costs:</b> In the beginning of the semester students may need ISIC or Estonian student card, some passport size photos, a library card, make some copies. 20-25 EUR per semester.
