Please note: Do not pay any money in advance if you have not received a proper rental contract! If possible, you should inspect the room yourself or make an appointment for a skype interview with your future flat-mates. If an offer you get sounds fishy or seems surprisingly cheap, you can e-mail the International Office for advice. Usually, you will be asked to pay a deposit (*Kaution*) which you get back after you have moved out and returned the room in a proper condition.

Estimated Living Expenses (per month)

Accommodation	€ 400 – € 500 per month (flat share)

Health insurance	Students need to have an international insurance in their home country
