LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	
Language Requirements	Exchange students do not have to pass an official language examination in French in order to qualify for enrollment at UPJV.  We do, however, expect intermediate language proficiency in French equivalent to B1 since not all departments offer courses in English. Please check with the departmental coordinators before you nominate the students.
