APPLICATIONS

Nomination deadlines :

First term: May 15th

Second term: October 15th

Application deadline (university enrolment and housing) :

First term: June 1st

Second term: November 1st

Language requirements :

Test of knowledge in French (B2 or C1 depending on the program) or a letter of a French teacher giving evidence of an equivalent level. For programs in another language, the test depends on the chosen program.

STUDY AT UMLP

Academic year

1st semester starts in early September and ends in early December before the Christmas break - the dates depend of the department you applied for.

2nd semester starts in early January and ends in early May - the dates depend of the department you applied for.

Semester 1 exams take place in early to mid-January.
Semester 2 exams take place in mid-late May.

Resit exams session -

If you have to take resit exams you have one session at the middle of June.
