Visa/immigration requirements	<ul> <li>Nordic citizens: If you are a Swedish, Danish, Icelandic, Finnish, or Norwegian citizen, all you need to do to live in Norway for more than six months, is to report a move to the National Registry: <u>Tax Administration Office</u></li> <li>EU/EEA citizens: If they are going to study and live in Norway for more than three months, they must register their arrival on <u>Students who are EU/EEA</u> <u>nationals - UDI</u></li> <li>Non-EU/EEA citizens: Students with citizenship from countries outside the EU/EEA zone must apply for Study Permit: <u>Want to apply: Study permit - UDI</u></li> </ul>
