ERASMUS+ STUDENTS:	Students must meet the requirements for each course and select most of the courses from within their subject field/degree and their host Erasmus+ Department at UiT.	
NON-ERASMUS+ STUDENTS:	Students must meet the requirements for each course and select most of the courses from within their subject field/degree.	
PROJECT/SCHOLARSHIP-BASED STUDENTS:	Students/nominator must contact the Project Coordinator at UiT or home university to identify the courses that the students are going to take during their exchange stay at UiT.	
COURSE WORKLOAD:	 30 ECTS is the normative workload per semester. Students can select up to 60 ECTS per semester if they meet the admission requirements for each course selected. 	
COURSE LEVELS:	• Bachelor's level courses: The numerical code is 1000 – 2000	

	• Master's level courses: The numerical code is 3000 – 4000
	Please note that master's level courses are only open for students with a bachelor's degree. The transcript of records of the bachelor's degree must be documented by the student during the application process.
CAMPUS AND COURSE SELECTION:	Students can ONLY select courses from one campus (city) per semester . It is not possible to mix courses from different campuses (cities) per semester.

TRAINEESHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

TRAINEESHIP AT UIT

We welcome applications for traineeships (work placements, internships, lab work, research related to thesis supervision, etc) from students from our partner institutions and guest students from only Erasmus+ institutions in Europe.

The traineeship must be of a duration of minimum 2 months and maximum period for an Erasmus+ Traineeship at UiT is limited to one academic year (i.e. two semesters) per study cycle (BA, MA, or Ph.D.). This applies regardless of whether there were two non-contiguous semesters.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MEDICAL / NURSING / MIDWIFERY / RADIOGRAPHY / CLINICAL ROTATION STUDENTS

We ONLY accept applications for traineeship from students coming from our partner universities.

TRAINEESHIP GUIDELINES

We strongly advise the nominator at the partner institution or the student to contact the partner department at UiT diretly to explore whether thy can host students for traineeship before their nomination to UiT.

ARRIVAL AND LIVING IN NORWAY

	It is the responsibility of the student to check which type of visa or registration (EU-EEA students) they will need and how to get it.
VISA/IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS:	If the student arrives at UiT The Arctic University of Norway without the appropriate visa which permit them to study in Norway for the duration of their exchange, they may face troubles with the local Immigration Office at the Police Department.

	In some cases, they may have to leave Norway
	and re-enter to get their immigration permission corrected.

INSURANCE:	Accident and third party liability: All international students (Incoming exchange students, joint-degree students and degree / programme students) at UiT The Arctic University of Norway must have adequate insurance coverage against theft, loss, illness, and liability before they leave home. We strongly advise you to buy travel insurance and to insure coverage of emergency travel home in the event of serious illness or any force majeure during your period of studies or traineeship at UiT.
