Nomination	<p>Partner institutions must nominate their students via Mobility-Online. Application	<p>Nominated students receive an email with the online application link and further instructions for admission and will then have to upload the following application documents in Mobility-Online:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photo • ID or passport • CV in English (or German) • Transcript of Records in English (or German) • Language Certificate for German and/or English B2 level (<i>not older than 2 years!</i>) <p>Deadline: 31 May 2024 (winter semester or full year) Deadline: 30 November 2024 (summer semester)</p>

Academic Calendar	<p>The Academic Year is divided into two semesters: Winter semester (October - March) Summer semester (April - September).</p> <p>Each semester consists of a fixed lecture period and recess weeks. Examination periods vary according to faculty or department, but usually take place at the end of the lecture period as well as in the first 2-3 weeks after. Language requirements	<p>Erasmus incoming students must submit a language certificate in German or English.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for courses in German: German B2 or • for courses in English: English B2 <p>Please note that the offer in English is limited in some subject areas. Therefore, students who will only take courses in English must check whether they can find enough English-taught courses to fulfil their home university's credit requirements. Basic German skills are highly recommended for daily life, even if students only study in English.</p>		
Course Offer	<p>Exchange students must choose their courses from the module catalogues for exchange students:</p> <p>https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/kursangebot/</p> <p>They are allowed to take courses at the faculty of the respective inter-institutional agreement. In addition, they may take courses from a second faculty if required by their degree programme and approved by the University of Augsburg during the application process. Language and intercultural courses are open to all exchange students. Exchange students must fulfil the academic and language requirements of the respective module.</p>

Workload	<p>Exchange students are expected to do coursework at the University of Augsburg. Please note that it is not possible to supervise any bachelor, master or PhD theses of Erasmus exchange students or award ECTS for independent research.</p> <p>The standard semester workload is 30 ECTS, however, exchange students are flexible and are not required to take a certain number of ECTS by the University of Augsburg. Students should discuss with their home university how many ECTS are expected.</p>		
Learning Agreement	<p>Learning Agreements must be submitted digitally via the EWP network. We prefer students to submit their learning agreements in September (winter</p>		

	<p>semester) or March (summer semester) when the course offer for the semester of the exchange is definite and there are therefore fewer changes necessary. However, if required by the partner university, students may submit their Learning Agreements earlier.</p>
Transcript of Records	<p>Transcript of Records only show the modules passed by the student. The document can be downloaded as a verifiable PDF by the student until 31 March (winter semester) or until 30 September (summer semester) from the University of Augsburg's examinations platform. The home university can verify the authenticity of the Transcript of Records via a dedicated verification website. Hard copies are no longer provided.</p>

Housing	<p>The International Office can arrange for a number of rooms in the student dormitories of the "Studentenwerk" (Please note that we cannot guarantee a dormitory room for every Erasmus student) https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/dormitories_exchange/</p>
Visa and Residence Permit	<p>EU citizens do not need to apply for visa. Non-EU citizens usually have to apply for a student visa. Health Insurance	<p>All EU students need to have a valid European health insurance card (EHIC) to be enrolled at the University of Augsburg. All non-EU students have to take out German public health insurance or proof of a private health insurance that is considered equivalent to German public health insurance to be enrolled. https://www.uni-augsburg.de/en/portal/internationals/erasmus/health-insurance/</p>
Special Needs	<p>Please indicate in your nomination if a student has special needs. We will then check how we can best address their individual needs.</p>
Fees	<p>There are no tuition fees for exchange students. Semester contribution of currently 150,63 EUR is mandatory to be enrolled at the University of Augsburg. This includes the students' semester travel tickets and other student services.</p>
Orientation Programme	<p>Each semester, an orientation programme is organised by the International Office in cooperation with ESN (Erasmus Student Network) before the start of lectures. Details will be provided by the International Office to all nominated students. It is highly recommended that students arrive in time for the orientation programme.</p>
Buddy Programme	<p>Each Erasmus student is allocated a buddy at the University of Augsburg. Buddies are University of Augsburg students who volunteer to support international students during their time in Augsburg (support in practical matters, help finding their way around campus, doing the course registration etc.)</p>
