1. Grading systems of the institutions

Evaluation criteria at ISAVE are based on a 0 to 20 point system. The best mark would be equal to 20 and the lowest mark would correspond to 0. The following table may be used for comparison with other evaluation systems:

ISAVE	ECTS	According to ECTS grading scale
19 - 20	A	EXCELLENT: a particularly outstanding achievement, with only minor errors

17 - 18	B	VERY GOOD: an achievement that lies above the average but with some errors
15 - 17	C	GOOD: an achievement that surpasses the average standard with a number of notable errors
12 - 14	D	SATISFACTORY: an achievement that fulfills the average standard but with significant shortcomings
10 - 11	E	SUFFICIENT: an achievement that fulfills the average standard, despite deficiencies. Some more work required before the credit can be awarded.
5 - 9	FX	FAIL: an achievement that suffers considerably from deficiencies. Some more work required before the credit can be awarded.
< 5	F	FAIL: indescribably bad performance, total absence or failure to take any exams or do any work. Considerable further work is required.
