Welcome orientation program	The University of Stuttgart offers an intensive German language course for exchange students from our partner universities. This course includes an orientation program (study counselling, group counselling on the formalities, excursions etc). We expect of our visiting program students who do not attend the intensive German course to participate in our orientation sessions previous to the lecture period. Students will receive useful information about studying and living in Stuttgart during the information session.
Language requirements	Either: proof of a German proficiency which corresponds to B1 according to the European Reference Frame AND participation in the intensive German course at the Universität Stuttgart. Or: proof of a English proficiency which corresponds to B2 (students who take only English courses).
