



English language requirements

Students are required to have B1 level knowledge of English. As proof of English knowledge, official language test results are required.

Institutional tests and/or certifications issued by professors or International Relations Offices cannot be accepted.

Exemptions

Submitting an English certificate is not required if:

- * the student has completed the secondary education in Australia, Canada (except Quebec), Ireland, New Zealand, the UK or the USA. Or in a school in which the medium of instruction is English
- * the student attends a University in which the medium of instruction is English. In this case, the University must issue a certificate stating, "The medium of instruction is English".

The student can be exempted if upon registration provides a stamped declaration/certificate written on official paper certifying one of the abovementioned cases.
