Details about documents

- **Application:** apply through [ApplyTexas](#) online. Pay the \$50 application fee by credit card to ensure a faster and more efficient processing time. It is important to note that we do not provide a fee waiver, and an application will not be processed if the application fee has not been paid.
- After applying online, the **application will be reviewed**, and a student will be registered in ASU system.
- Then an email will be sent **requesting the following documents** before a student is officially accepted:

1. Official Transcripts: Please provide your official academic transcripts from all institutions attended.

2. Language Proficiency Exam: All international applicants are required to submit proof of English Language Proficiency for admissions *if* they reside in a non-English speaking country. Please note: The Center for International Studies does identify English speaking countries – not the applicant.

Provide proof of English proficiency through one of the following:

- TOEFL – Test of English as a Foreign Language
- IELTS – International English Language Testing System
- Duolingo

3. Copy of ID Page: A clear PDF copy of the ID page of the passport. Photo attachments will not be accepted.

4. Official Bank Statement: a proof of funds for the tuition and time in the United States needs to be provided.

- An official statement from your bank proving availability of substantial funds while attending ASU in USD or equivalent in local currency.
- Special Note: \$11,155 is the approximate cost to attend Angelo State University for one semester.

5. Official ASU Financial Statement Form:

To be completed by the applicant's financial sponsor(s).

- **F-1 Visa Holder Responsibilities:** Your immigration record is your responsibility. Please use the [Study in the States](#) website as a guide for immigration rules for your F-1 visa. If you have questions about your F-1 visa requirements, please contact our office to speak with your Designated School Official at Angelo State University.

- **Student ID Card:** As a student, you will use your student ID card for many activities and facilities on the ASU campus. We recommend starting the process to obtain your ASU OneCard (Student ID Card) before you arrive. You can do so by following the process on the [ASU OneCard](#) webpage.
