Student Dormitory

Prior to moving to the Student Dormitory, it is mandatory to submit:

- 1. ID card
- 2. Medical certificate that there is no contraindication for accommodation in Student Dormitory.
- 3. Confirmation from home University that student is full time student.

Student will not be allowed to enter the Student Dormitory without ID card and Medical certificate.

General instructions/information about accommodation in Student Dormitory:

- 1. Electrical appliances (cookers, irons, etc.) are not allowed in the rooms. Students that are accommodated in Student Dormitory can use set board (iron and table) free of charge in the laundry room.
- 2. Students can bring their own computer and connect it to the computer network dorm (wire and wireless). Each student in the room has its own desk and lamp, and each room has a toilet, refrigerator and television. Beds in the Student Dormitory have complete linen (bedsheet), but students can bring their own, if they want to. Students can use the laundry service (washing and drying) within the Student Dormitory. Laundry service is included in the monthly rent.
- 3. Few important tips: Students needs to bring with them selves the cutlery/dinner set (plate, spoon, fork and knife), cups, glasses and other things that they might need.
- 4. Within the Student Dormitory, there is a multimedia classroom and gym which students can use free of charge.
- 5. Kitchenette is located on every floor. Student restaurant (Mensa) is in the proximity of the Student Dormitory.
- 6. Dormitory front desk is open 24 hours. (*this information is changeable)
- 7. The price of accommodation is around 900,00 Croatian kuna (HR KN) per month. You can check currency for every day on the web site of the Croatian National Bank.

- 8. Student is obligated to stay/pay in the Dorm until the end of semester (autumn semester: *under construction*/spring semester *under construction*).
- If student decides to leave Student Dormitory before the final date agreed in the contract between both parties (student and Student Dormitory¹), one is still mandatory to pay for the full rent.

¹ Final dates will be agreed on between student and Head of the Student Dormitory.

Registration upon arrival at Police station

1) Registration for students **EU nationality** is going to be provided by Juraj Dobrila University of Pula upon arrival to Pula.

Necessary documents for registration for temporary stay in Pula are:

- Copy of the ID card/passport first page (provided by student)
- Copy of the European Health Insurance Card (for EU citizens) or Health insurance policy
- Statement from Juraj Dobrila University of Pula about student status (provided upon arrival from Office for Partnership and Projects)
- <u>Fulfilled Form 1b</u> provided upon arrival in our Office for Partnership and Projects
- 2) Registration for students **non-EU nationality**, within **48 hours after crossing the border**, student must register:

1. Short term stay registration

- -> at Police station Istarska (Trg Republike 1, 52100, Pula). Owner of the apartment, along with the student, must do the procedure of registration. Student must fullfill Form 8a;
- -> at Police station Istarska (Trg Republike 1, 52100, Pula). Student can do the registration procedure by themselves with signed and verified contract with flatowner. Student must fullfill $\underline{\text{Form 8a}}$;
- -> or do the short registration via **eVisitor** (tourist registration system).

2. Temporary registration

- **2.1. Temporary registration** for students non-EU nationality but with regulated temporary stay in EU country
- -> student must send temporary residence permit card in application procedure

Necessary documents for **registration for temporary stay** in Pula are:

- Copy of the passport first page (provided by student);
- Copy of the Health insurance policy;
- proof of short stay registration;
- Temporary residence permit card regulated in EU country;
- Statement from Juraj Dobrila University of Pula about student status (provided upon arrival from Office for Partnership and Projects);
- Fulfilled Form 8a provided upon arrival in our Office for Partnership and Projects.
- **2.2. Temporary registration** for students non-EU nationality will be provided by Juraj Dobrila University of Pula upon arrival to Pula.

Necessary documents for **registration for temporary stay** in Pula are:



	 Copy of the passport – first page (provided by student); Copy of the Health insurance policy; proof of short stay registration; Statement from Juraj Dobrila University of Pula about student status (provided upon arrival from Office for Partnership and Projects); Fulfilled Form 1a - provided upon arrival in our Office for Partnership and Projects (for students with not regulated temporary stay in EU country). Process of approving of the temporary residence is taking around one (1) month and during this time, student is not recommended to leave the country of residence (we do not guarantee re-entry into the Republic of Croatia because the approval process is ongoing). After approving temporary residence permit in Croatia (for students with not regulated temporary stay in EU country), student is mandatory to pay: 350,00 HR KN – approval of temporary residence permit; 240,00 HR KN – making of ID card for temporary residence permit; 70,00 HR KN – national landmark; and bring one (1) biometrical picture size 35 x 45 mm.

With VAT/OIB number students will go to University Student Office and receive X card – student card. ²
