F. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

The ECTS system initially divides students between pass and fail groups and then assesses the performance of these two groups separately. Those obtaining passing grades are divided into five subgroups:

the best 10% are awarded an A grade,
the next 25% a B grade,
the following 30% a C,
the following 25% a D
and the final 10% an E.

ECTS Grade	best/next	Definition
A	10 %	Excellent - noteworthy result which may contain some minor errors
B	25 %	Very good - above average result
C	30 %	Good - generally good work despite errors
D	25 %	Satisfactory – good effort but containing errors and/or omissions
E	10 %	Pass – result satisfying minimum pass criteria.
FX		Fail - additional work is required to obtain credits
F		Bad fail - considerable additional work is required to obtain credits
