Application forms and exchange-related information	<p>General Information at: Student's Handbook</p> <p>Online Applications at: https://inforestudiante.uac.pt/</p> <p>The student must register first and then fill in Incoming Mobility and Incoming Applications. The student must complete the online form and attach all the required documents. In case the student's University is working with the OLA version of the LA, it's required to be available for our signature at the OLA (Online Learning Agreement dashboard).</p> <p>Please note the following information: as the Nursing degree is taught in two different campus, located in two different islands (São Miguel and Terceira), students may be placed also in Terceira island. Courses in Clinical Teaching have limited places.</p>
Language Requirements	<p>At the UAc the language of instruction is portuguese, however, we provide a tutorial system in english to Erasmus students. Therefore, in order to communicate properly and to attend classes successfully, during the mobility period, it's absolutely important having the following language proficiency upon the arrival: Portuguese level B1 or English level B1.</p> <p>Since 2016/2017 the European linguistic platform (OLS) offers you a course in Portuguese and English languages. We strongly recommend that you evaluate your level of knowledge of the language (portuguese or english), and, if needed, take the course online. Ask your University for access to OLS.</p>
Portuguese Foreign Language	<p>Portuguese Languages classes, in the UAc, the courses are recommended and start on the first day of classes in the first semester (September) or in February/March for the second semester.</p> <p>The Portuguese course in Angra do Heroísmo campus requires a minimum of 10 students enrolled.</p>



	The PLE course has an administrative fee, nonrefundable, of 25,00€, paid upon the arrival. To enrollment in this course is done upon a survey that will be send by the University of the Azores. Students will receive the payment instructions, by email.

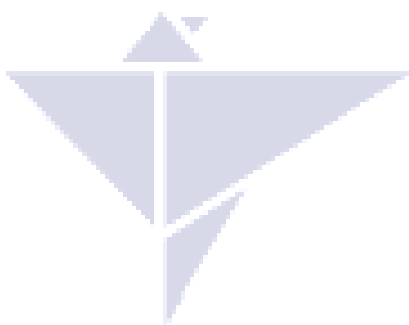

<p>Housing Information</p>	<p>The ERO advises students to apply to the accommodation in our students residence. Students should submit their application online through the portal: https://servicosonline.uac.pt/, then click on Alojamento/Accommodation and then choose the form application (registration is required, before applying). The residence has limited rooms, so if you have no place to stay, you should look for a place to live. It's very easy to find a shared apartment. You can stay in a hostel or hotel for the first few days, while looking for permanent accommodation. You can ask for help in the Academic Association of the University of the Azores.</p>

Safety and Health	<p>European Health Insurance Card, compulsory for all EU students (except Turkish). A private health policy is also mandatory for non-European students.</p> <p>The UAc offers an accident student insurance to all exchange students by paying a fee (3.05€). It's mandatory.</p>
Immigration Requirements	<p>EU students (except Turkish): identity card or Passport.</p> <p>Non-European and Turkish students must arrive with a student visa. <u>The visa request must consider the duration of the mobility (1 semester or 1 year)</u>. Upon arrival (in the first three days), Non-European and Turkish students must go to SEF (border services). Further informations here.</p>
