ACADEMIC SEMESTER AT UNIMAGDALENA

This mobility scheme allows undergraduate and graduate students enrolled both in Colombian and foreign partner HEIs of Universidad del Magdalena (those with a signed academic mobility agreement), to undertake up to two (2) academic semesters in the city of Santa Marta - Colombia. Students can benefit from the recognition of the academic credits earned by approving the subjects taken at our University, as stated in the student's learning agreement, at their Home Institution.

MEDICAL INTERNSHIP FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

This opportunity for student from partner HEIs (those with a signed academic mobility agreement) strives for integrating and applying the knowledge, skills and experience acquired during the years of training in medicine, paving the way for the medical praxis, as traditionally performed in a sociomedical scenario. Internship activities include: diagnosis and treatment of the most frequent pathologies in the territory, as well as actions aimed at health promotion, disease prevention and rehabilitation of the patient in fundamental areas of the discipline.

Internship rotations:

- · Pediatrics.
- · Gynecology and obstetrics
- Internal Medicine
- General surgery

- Emergency Medical Specialties
- Optional pathway in Sports Medicine



RESEARCH STAYS

This opportunity allows students and professors with a research background drawn from national or international institutions to develop research competencies by joining a research group, center or institute of Universidad del Magdalena that develops scientific activities related to their disciplinary area or field of knowledge. This could be done with an original research project or an existing one at our university.

This opportunity is available throughout the academic year. It is exempt from fees and does not require an existing bilateral student/staff mobility agreement.



Visiting researchers are granted complete access to our campus facilities, library and laboratories. They are also welcome to join the regular engagement and cultural activities available for international students, with the support of the International Office.

Completion of rotations	Must have a minimum duration of three months and a maximum of one year.

Documents needed for your application:

Fill out the form (<u>click here</u>) to apply for your academic mobility, and submit it by uploading the following documents:

- Copy of the Passport or Visa.
- Nomination letter signed by the International Relations Office, or its equivalent.
- Academic Transcript of Records.
- Spanish language certificate (B1 level, if applicable).



NOTE:

- International students who are accepted for a medical internship at UNIMAGDALENA must send a photocopy of their vaccination card with the following vaccination schedule:
- · Influenza 2025.
- · Tetanus (complete schedule).
- · Hepatitis B (three doses) and antibody titers.
- · Varicella vaccine (two doses) and Varicella zoster IgG antibodies in serum.
- · Yellow fever (one dose).
- · COVID (full dose).
- Students must have international medical insurance that includes repatriation and, if possible, coverage for tropical diseases. This insurance must be valid for the entire duration of their stay in the country.
- Consult the requirements and immigration procedures in this link.
- During his/her stay, the student will be subject to the student regulations and institutional procedures of the Universidad del Magdalena. Likewise, he/she must be attentive to the indications and communications of his/her home institution.
- If the student wishes to extend his/her mobility period up to a maximum of one year, he/she must notify both institutions in advance to obtain the corresponding approval. Subsequently, he/she must initiate the visa renewal process before the local Migration Authorities (Migración Colombia).
- Once the student is accepted, we will send a guide with information on academic matters, accommodation, tourist sites, etc.
- Medical students who are accepted to carry out medical rotations at the University must, prior to starting their mobility, obtain a student visa. This document is essential to process their enrollment in the civil liability insurance and the Occupational Risk Insurance (ARL), both of which are required for the proper commencement of the rotations. Payment of the University of Magdalena's student emergency insurance and ID card is mandatory for all students each semester (approx. USD 10).
