German language skills are an asset and we recommend at least level A1. However, it is not a pre – condition (4) If you study with us in German: your German language skills are at least level B1.

<p><b>How to get to KSH</b></p>	<p><u>By plane:</u> Munich airport „Franz-Joseph-Strauß“ (<a href="https://www.munich-airport.com/">https://www.munich-airport.com/</a>) Memmingen airport (<a href="https://www.allgaeu-airport.com/">https://www.allgaeu-airport.com/</a>) - 1 ½ hours bus ride to Munich city center</p> <p><u>By train:</u> Train Station Munich (<a href="http://www.bahn.de">www.bahn.de</a>) Train Station Benediktbeuern (<a href="http://www.bahn.de">www.bahn.de</a>)</p> <p><u>By bus:</u> Munich central bus station (<a href="http://www.muenchen-zob.de/en">www.muenchen-zob.de/en</a>)</p> <p>Please note that for travelling to Benediktbeuern using plane/bus/train, you always need to pass Munich.</p>
<p><b>Public Transportation</b></p>	<p><b>Munich:</b> public transportation ticket / one semester costs €193. <a href="http://www.mvv-muenchen.de/en/homepage/index.html">www.mvv-muenchen.de/en/homepage/index.html</a></p> <p><b>Benediktbeuern:</b> There is no public transportation needed. Train ticket one way to Munich costs €14,60 <a href="http://www.bahn.com/en/view/index.shtml">www.bahn.com/en/view/index.shtml</a></p>
<p><b>How to find Accommodation</b></p>	<p>The KSH supports international students to find housing but cannot guarantee for Munich since the housing market is very stretched.</p>
<p><b>Cost of Accommodation</b></p>	<p><b>Munich:</b> Costs range between € 300 – € 400 for a room in a student dormitory and about € 600 on the free market (e.g. shared housing)</p> <p><b>Benediktbeuern:</b> €250 – €300 in a student dormitory / shared housing.</p>
