Language requirements for French and English	Grenoble INP – Ensimag Grenoble INP – Esisar Grenoble INP – Génie Industriel Grenoble INP – Phelma Grenoble INP – Ense³ Grenoble INP – Pagora	A B1 level is required in English and French for students to the double engineering degree program. A B1 level is required in French for exchange students wishing to take courses in French. A B2 level is required in English for exchange students or those enrolled in a master double degree program who wish to take courses in English.
	Grenoble IAE - INP (Graduate School of Management)	A B2 level is required either in French or in English depending if students follow classes in either language.
	Polytech Grenoble – INP, UGA	A B1 level is required in English and French for students to the double engineering degree program. A B1 Level is recommended for Exchange students
	<u>For students being nominated for an engineering double degree program.</u> Please note that from now on, in order to graduate, international students will have now to obtain a B2 level in French and in English if they follow courses in French, and a level B2 in English and B1 in French if they follow courses in English. This rule applies to all engineering degrees in France. Grenoble INP-UGA will ensure that students can take exams in both English and French during their stay in Grenoble. (<i>Students applying for a master double degree program are not concerned</i>). To attest the level in French and/or English, students must provide either an official test or a certificate from a language instructor stating the CECR Level	

	equivalence.
French grading system	Grenoble INP – UGA uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) . One academic year corresponds to 60 ECTS, one semester to 30 ECTS. Exchange students must take a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester or 60 ECTS per year.

Academic Calendar	The start and end dates of classes vary from one school to another and depend on the study level at which students enter the school. Please refer to the host school to know exactly when the semester is beginning and ending.

Nomination	Nominations must be made via MoveON using the following link: https://grenobl22.moveonfr.com/form/66bb511f0a840ee86a0d991a/eng To proceed with your student nominations, please create an account on MoveON. Once the students are nominated, you will receive a confirmation email from us. <u>Therefore, it is no longer necessary to send your nominations by email.</u> If necessary, you can fill in several forms if you need to nominate students later on. Deadline for nominations	- Full academic year or Fall semester: From March 1st to April 1st <i>Excepted for Grenoble INP – Polytech : From March 1st to May 30th</i> - Spring semester: From September 15th to October 25th Note: Polytech Grenoble – INP do not accept nominations for the Spring semester only.
Application	Incoming students have to complete an online application form (there is no need to send documents by e-mail or mail). Student visa requirements	https://international.univ-grenoble-alpes.fr/getting-organized/visas-and-residence-permits/ Students, excepted for residents of the European Union (EU-EEA), have to apply for a student visa at the French Embassy of their country of residence. It is highly recommended to start this procedure very early. Some Students have to apply to the CEF online procedure as well (72 countries are concerned): https://www.campusfrance.org/en/procedure-studying-in-France
Health insurance	Social Security provides foreign students with social coverage while studying in France. To increase the amount of their healthcare expenses that is reimbursed, they may take out complementary health insurance, or <i>mutuelle</i>. Subscription to Social Security is mandatory (upon arrival) for stays of more than 3 months, unless there is a bilateral agreement between France and the country of origin of students. This is the case for all member states of the European Union, European Economic Area, as well as Switzerland and Quebec. In this case, students must fill the appropriate paperwork before their arrival in France.
