Once the student has submitted their online application to us they will be sent <b>specific instructions</b> on how and where to upload their portfolio images. The quality of the portfolio can be the deciding factor in whether a student is accepted or not.

<b>Transcripts</b>	For Semester 1 students transcripts of results will be issued mid to late January to student and home institution For Semester 2 or Full year students transcripts of results will be issued mid to late July to student and home institution
<b>Insurance</b>	Applicants are advised to have the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) for studies abroad and also private travel and health insurance for the duration of their Erasmus studies at Dundee.
