Nominations are welcome by email (to nomination@uni-wuerzburg.de) by 30 April for the winter semester and 30 November for the summer semester by your home university coordinator. Please insert your official Erasmus code in the email subject. The following information should be included: Name of nominee(s), email address, field and level of study, language proficiency, period of stay and other relevant information (e.g. special needs). Important: Nominees have to be enrolled at your institution.

CREDIT SYSTEM

JMU uses the European Credit Transfer System. In general, one class equals 5 ECTS. The number of ECTS points for seminars or special modules can vary.

WORKLOAD

Typically the workload of one semester is 30 ECTS and equals a full-time study. We recommend international students to attend up to 5-6 classes per semester.

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

The Transcript of Records can be issued by the student in WueStudy. You should find all you grades up to 6 weeks after the last exam you took.
