'Do' and 'make' in Slavic languages: the case of Slovene *delati* and its counterparts

Our talk is focused on generic activity verbs in Slovene and other Slavic languages. The Slovenian pair *delati* 'to do, to work' and *narediti* 'to do, to make' is compared with its counterparts in South (Štokavian) and East Slavic (Ukrainian and Russian) languages. The various types of the use of these verbs are classified based on the most frequent syntactic constructions in which they occur.

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
